Background and Technology

Ileostomy is a commonly performed colorectal operation in which patients have to wear a stoma on the outside of the body for a certain period of time in order to remove excrement while part of the bowel heals. What happens is that patients are often readmitted to hospital due to dehydration and this is where this application comes in as it teaches patients to recognise signs of dehydration and provides simple guidelines to reduce the possible side effects of this operation.

Applications

The main and only use of this application is to help patients recognise the signs of dehydration after the operation so that they do not have to be re-admitted and to reduce any possible complications.
